

LOCAL BURN BAN LIFTED

The NYS DEC has chosen to **RELAX** the municipal ban, for the next year, on open burning in Towns with less than 20,000 residents.

Limbs and brush generated from within the Town of Lake Pleasant; less than 6 inches in diameter, and 8 feet in length, will be accepted at the Town's burning pit in the Village of Speculator.

The Town will work with the Village to insure safe, orderly management of this property, and thank the Adirondack Association of Towns and Villages for their tireless advocacy of this exemption.

Our small businesses and homeowner's are truly better served by this sensible handling of our extraneous limbs and brush.

We ask that our Town's people drop their brush at the pit, behind the tennis courts on Elm Lake Road, from 9-5, Monday – Saturday for municipal controlled burning.
