Summers - Monday and Thursday: 6/1/10 - 10/30/10

Recyclables Every Tuesday: Year-Round

## **Village of Speculator**

Residential garbage pick-up: Monday & Thursday:

Starts June 1, 2010 ----- ends October 30, 2010

(Monday Only During the Winter)

Recyclables Every Tuesday June through September  
(Second and Last Tuesday of Month During the Winter)

## **Town & Village Joint Clean-up Days:**

### **Wednesdays**

## **RECOMMENDATIONS**

CONSULT with the attendant at the transfer station,  
before dropping off materials.

DO NOT place household garbage curbside until the evening before,  
or preferably, the morning of pick-up day, before 7:00 a.m.

**USE a suitable container with lid for household garbage,  
with a clear plastic bag liner.**

A container is to weigh no more than 40 pounds.

Items for pick-up are to be placed curbside at the resident's property only.

**FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN A PENALTY  
PLEASE DO YOUR PART: KEEP OUR TOWN & VILLAGE CLEAN.**

**RECYCLING AND GARBAGE REGULATION**  
**\*\*\*\*\*USE CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS\*\*\*\*\***

**GLASS:** Rinse your GLASS food and beverage containers. Remove the caps and neck rings. You do not have to remove labels. **Do not** include glass items with metal such as light bulbs or other non-glass material.

**PLASTIC:** Remove the caps and neck rings from PLASTIC food, beverage, and household containers. Rinse. Flatten if you wish. You **do not** have to remove labels. **Do not** include plastic items such as plastic caps, styrofoam containers, oil containers, plastic bags, six-pack holders, medicine bottles. Containers with #1 or #2 on the bottom are recyclable.

**METAL:** Rinse out your METAL food and beverage containers. You **do not** have to remove labels & flatten them. **Do not** include other metal materials such as bottle caps, oil paint, pesticide or aerosol cans, or hangers.

**PAPER:** Slide your NEWSPAPER and inserts into a paper bag. You may tie in bundles with string only. Keep clean and dry. **Do not** intersperse magazines, junk mail, glossy print, etc. These are garbage. Magazine and books can be bundled separately, or placed in garbage.

**CARDBOARD:** Flatten your CORRUGATED CARDBOARD, and tie it up. Keep it clean and dry. **Do not** include other types of cardboard such as pizza boxes, cereal boxes, milk and egg cartons, etc.

**HOUSEHOLD GARBAGE** must be in **clear bags** – to make it possible to inspect for materials that should be recycled. **NON-RECYCLABLES:** To be discarded with household garbage.

**“IF IT’S NOT RECYCLABLE, IT’S GARBAGE”**

The transfer station has areas for **Construction Material (C&D)**. This will not get picked up.

**GREEN WASTE:** Grass clippings and leaves may be dropped **separately** at the composte area in back of the Town Municipal Center.....NO BAGS PLEASE.

**BRUSH:** In light of DEC’s recent burn ban going into effect...

**Municipal burning of brush is no longer permitted.** Homeowners will be responsible for the chipping/removal or private burning of limbs and such. The wisdom of this policy has been questioned from a safety and air quality standpoint by our town and county boards. Once again... you are urged to express your thoughts to your state elected officials and DEC.

**MAJOR APPLIANCES, LARGE HOUSEHOLD FURNISHINGS, TIRES & SCRAP METAL:** Can be brought to designated area at the transfer station, or be picked-up curbside on certain designated “CLEAN-UP DAYS”. Dismantle appliance, so it will not be a public hazard. Sort wood and metal. All rims off tires.

**HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE:** Batteries (including automobile), oil-based paint cans, pesticides, petroleum products, etc., shall be placed in a **separate** suitable container, and can be picked up on “CLEAN-UP DAYS” or brought to a designated area at the transfer station.

**TOWN DUMPSTER:** Our town residents are urged to utilize the dumpster at the Municipal Center...if they are leaving town, missing garbage collections.
